

What to do after 1st day meeting before dinner?

At the end of the meeting, you'll have the possibility to walk around Milan and visit its most famous spots. Take the Metro Green M2 from Assago MilanoFiori Forum stop (15 min walk from the Event Venue).



If you want to visit Milan Historical City Center you can stop at Lanza (in blue) and then have a walk in the Sforza Castle and the park around it. There are different bars where you can have an aperitivo or you can just sit inside an enjoy one of the best green areas in the city.

Otherwise you can continue visiting the city and move to Duomo Cathedral, have a look of the famous "Teatro alla Scala" where lot of famous operas take place during the whole year and walk in the "Quadrilatero della moda" where you can see high fashion shops with all the most famous Italian brands. If you prefer a more artistic feeling you can move to Pinacoteca di Brera, with its School of Arts and Museum and lost yourself in the small streets around the district, full of bars and typical liberty buildings.
